

## MERIDIAN GROUND RULES

1. Under no circumstances are students allowed to bring cell phones , MP3 players or other electronic devices into the classroom. Otherwise , they will be confiscated and students' parents will be able to collect them at the end of school day from the Vice Principal.
2. No food is allowed in the classrooms.
3. Chewing gum on school premises is strictly forbidden.
4. Sitting and lying on the floor is strictly forbidden.
5. Students shall not take advantage of the school bus service they should proceed to their bus directly following their last lessons .
6. Students have to systematically attend all obligatory lessons.
7. Students have to be on-time for all lessons and they are not allowed to leave the school until they are finished with their last lesson of the day.
8. Absence must be excused in a written form by parents/guardians and delivered to the class teacher within 7 days of said absence.
9. Students have to carry out all obligatory and voluntary duties properly and decently.
10. Students have to show respect towards all students, teachers, administration staff and other workers of the school.

11. Students are forbidden to bring or drink alcohol, smoke cigarette, use or distribute drugs and other intoxicants on the campus , in its neighborhood or during various events organized by the school (trips , competitions, etc.). This also includes entering the premises under the influence of any of these substances.
12. Students should respect their own as well as the schools honor and reputation.
13. Students aren't allowed to leave the classroom during a lesson . Using the toilet is not allowed during any lesson.
14. Students can't go home without parents' written excuse . In case of an emergency (e.g. sickness) the students has to stay at school until parents come and take him/her home.
15. Tattoos, facial and body piercing are not acceptable.
16. Extreme hairstyles will not be permitted (hair cannot be dyed in pink , blue , yellow green etc. , no spiky hair , tails for boys). Student's hair cannot block the eyes or completely cover the fore head.
17. In case of emergency excuses, students are obliged to present the situation to the principle/vice principle , who then decides whether the student may leave the school premises.
18. Students are expected to wear clothing that is appropriate for a school environment. Anything that may distract from learning can be seen as offensive for students or faculty.
